Rules

Rules explain expectations to students and establish rewards or consequences.



Redirect

Redirection guides students back on task when they're disruptive or distracted.




Transitions

Transition warnings allow students to prepare for a change.




Neutral Tone

When a student is not following directions, maintaining a calm tone and neutral face will help you both keep your cool.



Modeling

Modeling demonstrates desirable behaviors to your students.



Choices

Choices empower students to feel a healthy level of control and take ownership of decisions.




When-Then

Provides a prompt to students on what the expected behavior is & what will happen upon compliance.



Recovery

Allows both teacher and student to use PRIDE skills to return to a positive state after an expectation has been met.



Redoing

Allows student to complete a task the correct and safe way with a good attitude.
